COLOUR

Black

While great care is taker with the colour sample shown, no guarantee can be given that it represents exactly the colour offered.

PREPARATION & APPLICATION

SURFACE PREPARATION

The surface should be dry and free from any loose material. Moss etc., should be removed by scraping, wire brushing and/or jet washing and the surface allowed to dry.

APPLICATION

Give the container a thorough shake since some settlement can occur during storage. The product can be applied using a texturing roller or by a soft broom. If a texturing roller is selected, the solution should be applied from a roller tray and worked out well using the roller to avoid the product pooling and reducing coverage.

If using a soft broom, simply pour the product directly from the container onto the surface. The product can then be worked around the required area, sweeping the broom in every direction. (Please note that the bristles can stiffen after a while making the sweeping action more difficult.)

During and immediately after application the product will appear brown, but will become to a uniform black as it dries. If the substrate is fairly porous, a second coat can be applied as soon as the first coat is tack free.

SAFETY

Wear gloves and protective eyewear in case of splashes. If the product comes into contact with eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes and seek medical advice. Material Safety Datasheets are available on request.
