### Applications

UltraCrete Line Marking Paint (LMP) is a solvent based marking paint, ideal as an effective and quick method for line or spot marking in road and pot hole repairs, car parks, warehouses, building sites, sports areas, excavation sites, mining, turf marking and landscape sites. The semi-permanent formula is effective for at least 3 months after application under normal wear conditions.

### Technical

LMP is supplied in 750ml aerosol cans and is available in White (MP1), Yellow (MP2) and Blue (MP4). The colour of the plastic cap on the aerosol tin denotes the colour of the product. When placing an order, please quote the code numbers above to indicate the colour required.

### Application

Ensure the surface to be marked is dry and free from dust. Shake the aerosol tin well for 2-3 minutes. Invert can and spray in even strokes from a distance of 175mm-250mm (7"-10") from the surface to be marked. After use turn can upright and spray for 1-2 seconds to clear nozzle. Product will cover almost any surface including epoxy resin coatings. Note: Please take care when clearing the nozzle and painting; do not paint in windy conditions.

### Storage

Aerosol cans must NOT be exposed to direct sunlight or temperatures above 50°C. Store in a cool well-ventilated place.

### Shelf life

Shelf life in correct conditions for sealed packaging is 6 months. In cold weather conditions, storing overnight at room temperature will assist application.

### Disposal

Pressurised container. Do not pierce or burn, even after use.

### Health, Safety and Environmental

Please ensure that appropriate PPE is used when preparing, mixing and applying products. Always wash your hands before consuming food and make sure that materials are kept safely out of reach of children and animals. Please dispose of packaging and waste responsibly and in accordance with local authority requirements.
